

## Radon and Radon Decay Product Measurement Course (CERTI-1)

### **Notice to Individuals planning to sit for the NRPP Radon Measurement Professional Exam**

NRPP has revised its radon measurement exam and all candidates planning to sit for the exam after April 30, 2021 will be sitting for the new exam. According to NRPP, the new exam is more focused on skills needed in today's environment as well as expands upon aspects of operating a measurement business such as recordkeeping.

To assist our students, we have revised Topic 9 within the CERTI measurement course (CERTI-1) to reflect the skill domains now stated by NRPP and are the basis of the new exam.

- **If you have already completed Topic 9 but not yet generated your CERTI course certificate**, you will need to run through Topic 9 again including the quiz before the certificate will be generated.
- **If you have already generated your course certificate but not yet taken the NRPP exam**, we encourage you to complete Topic 9.

At this link you will see descriptions of two credentials: **Measurement Technician** and **Measurement Professional**. The Measurement Technician is a new lower tier credential that will be introduced in August of 2021 and therefore not currently available. The new NRPP exam is for the upper tier Radon Measurement Professional, which is what the CERTI course covers and prepares you for.

The CERTI course content is still very relevant and the revision within Topic 9 helps prepare you for the NRPP exam.

If you are planning to become certified by NRSB we have not been notified of any changes, so you are good to go.
